

# How do I make Positive Bible Affirmations?

The process to making biblical affirmations is writing the Bible verses into a statement. If the Bible says, "Do not fear." Then you would write, I will not fear. I will trust in the lord.

If the Bible says that we can have wisdom if we ask God. You can write, "I will thank God for his wisdom." Or, "I am wise because of the gifts of God."

For instance, you can take this long bible verse and turn it into 11 affirmation statements.

**VERSE:** "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the **peace** of God, which **surpasses all understanding**, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." Phillipians 4:6-7

#### 12 BIBLICAL AFFIRMATION STATEMENTS:

- 1. I am loved, heard, and understood by God.
- 2. My prayers are powerful.
- 3. I am safe in God and have nothing to be anxious about.
- 4. I will submit my thoughts to God.
- 5. God cares for me, so I will let him know what I need.
- 6. God will bless me with peace.
- 7. I have access to the protection of God.
- 8. God will protect my mind from the enemy.
- 9. God will ensure my heart stays pure, joyful, and healed.



# **FAQS**

**Are affirmations biblical?** Affirmations are statements that come from Bible verses. the Bible instructs us to store up the word of God in our heart and mediate on it. "I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you." Psalm 119:11

Are affirmations a sin? No, affirmations are God's word written as a short phrase. "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success." Joshua 1:8

**Should I say affirmations out loud?** You should say them out loud and repeat them silently. This way you hear yourself doing the act and get encouraged. But, saying them in your head will train you to repeat scriptures when you're in a crowd of people!

**Is it a sin to manifest?** Manifesting becomes a sin when you think you're entitled to getting what you want and how you want it. However, the Bible says ask anything according to God's will and it will be done. It says delight in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart. Manifesting is simply trusting in God and walking in faith that He heard you. It's preparing for the miracle before it has happened. But, as Christians we must be sure that we are opened to hearing God say **NO**, **WAIT**, **or GO** the opposite way of what we expected.
