My Testimony of God's Protection

My focus on prayer began in 2009 when God spoke to me audibly, saying: "If I didn't make you wait, you wouldn't have prayed. Make sure that you pray from now on!" Since then, God has protected me through dreams, people, His Word, and miraculous interventions.

For example, my sister once dreamed of our family being attacked by a demon, and the dream showed her removing it with honey—symbolizing the need for Christ's love and kindness to overcome harmful words. I've also received dreams warning me about betrayal, guiding me in tests, and alerting me to pray against spiritual attacks.

Prayer—especially praying God's Word—is vital. It reminds you of God's promises when the enemy tries to fill your heart with fear and doubt. God uses dreams, Scripture, and His messengers to assure you that He is always with you, empowering you with spiritual authority.

God's protection is real and active. By renewing your mind and submitting to God's ways, you build strength to stand against the enemy's attacks. Satan wants to steal your peace and faith through fear and pain—pray boldly against it, and trust that God wants to keep you safe.

Eternal father, I look to you for guidance today. I ask that you keep the evil one away from me and my family. I believe in the power of God. I believe in your ability to cancel disease, spiritual attacks, and the satanic strongholds in the life of my family members and children. Help me to put on the shield of faith, so I can always believe you love your children and you want to protect and guide us. I thank you that God's hand is stronger than evil spirits, evil arrows, a human's evil tongue, job loss, car crashes, and anything the enemy would throw at me.

These instructions were a strategic plan of warfare. Overall, darkness can't survive when God's love, truth, and righteousness are present <u>within YOU.</u>

My spiritual warfare experiences taught me...

My experiences and dreams taught me that we battle against evil, not against people (Ephesians 6:12). Often, people are spiritually blinded, leading to behaviors like selfishness and narcissism. As Acts 26:18 urges, our hope is to open their eyes from darkness to light, steering them away from the power of Satan towards God's forgiveness and sanctification through faith.

15 Secrets of Spiritual Warfare

1. Put on the Full Armor & Stand in Authority

Why: Spiritual warfare requires preparation and protection. The armor of God equips believers with spiritual defenses and authority to stand firm against the enemy's attacks (Ephesians 6:10-18). Without this, we're vulnerable.

- Father, I put on the full armor of God—truth, righteousness, peace, faith, salvation, and the sword of the Spirit.
- I stand firm, covered by the blood of Jesus, and resist every plan of the enemy.
- Thank you that I have authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy—nothing shall harm me (Luke 10:19).

2. Fix Your Mind on Heaven & Resist Fear

Why: The battlefield often starts in the mind. Focusing on God's peace and truth counters fear and anxiety—primary weapons the enemy uses to destabilize believers (2 Corinthians 10:5).

- Even when the enemy tries to cloud my thoughts with anxiety or fear, I choose to rest in your perfect peace (Philippians 4:6–8, 2 Corinthians 10:5).
- Holy Spirit, renew my mind to focus on what is lovely, pure, and true.
- I cast down every lie and imagination that sets itself up against You.

3. Fight Spiritual Forces, Not People

Why: Recognizing that the real enemy is not flesh and blood but spiritual forces helps avoid personal bitterness and misuse of power, redirecting the fight to where it truly belongs (Ephesians 6:12).

- Lord, open my eyes to see beyond the physical.
- This battle isn't against people, but against principalities.
- Help me respond with love and spiritual weapons, not carnal ones.
- I break every demonic cycle attempting to operate through offense, division, or manipulation in my life, family, and community (Ephesians 6:12, 2 Corinthians 10:4–5).

4. Let God Fight Your Battles & Stay in Peace

Why: Trying to control or seek revenge feeds the enemy. Trusting God to fight brings peace and righteousness rather than more conflict (Psalm 46:10).

- I surrender my desire for revenge and control. You are my defender.
- I will be still and know you are God (Psalm 46:10).
- Heal the wounds from injustice, and restore my peace where strife tried to settle in my heart.
- I choose to respond in love, trusting you to bring justice (Romans 12:19).

5. Trust God's Character & Timing

Why: Doubt and impatience open doors for discouragement. Knowing God is faithful and works all things for good anchors the believer in hope during spiritual conflict (Numbers 23:19).

- God, I reject every lie that says you're late or unfaithful.
- You are not a man that you should lie. I stand firm in your promises and trust that you are working, even when I can't see it.
- Uproot bitterness, doubt, and discouragement.
- Fill me with hope and patience as I wait for your perfect plan (Numbers 23:19, Romans 8:28).

6. Pursue Intimacy & Fast with Purpose

Why: Spiritual power and clarity come through close relationship with God and intentional fasting, which purifies and sharpens sensitivity to His guidance (Joel 2:12-13).

- I don't just want results—I want you, Lord.
- As I fast and pray, draw me into deeper intimacy and spiritual clarity.
- Expose hidden sin, dismantle idols, and align my heart with heaven's priorities.
- Let this time of fasting purify and empower me (Joel 2:12–13, Matthew 6:16–18).

7. Cleanse My Heart & Renew My Mind

Why: Internal sin and wrong motives weaken spiritual defense. A renewed heart and mind align the believer with God's will, strengthening their position in the battle (Psalm 51:10).

- Create in me a clean heart, O God.
- Remove selfish ambition, pride, jealousy, and impure motives.
- Let me not just speak truth, but live it.

 Shape my thoughts and desires to reflect your will, not my own (Psalm 51:10, Romans 12:2).

8. Resist Temptation & Walk in Power

Why: Temptations are a battlefield tactic to weaken and distract. Resisting temptation keeps believers strong and walking by the Spirit (1 Corinthians 10:13).

- Thank you, Father, that no temptation is too great.
- You provide a way of escape every time.
- Empower me to resist compromise, even when I'm weary.
- Let me walk in the Spirit, not the flesh (1 Corinthians 10:13, Galatians 5:16).

9. Discern Spirits & Watch for Wolves

Why: Not every spiritual encounter is safe. Discernment protects from deception, false teachings, and harmful relationships that can sabotage spiritual victory (1 John 4:1).

- Holy Spirit, sharpen my discernment.
- Help me test every spirit and recognize deception masked in kindness or spiritual language.
- Reveal hidden motives, false teachings, and toxic soul ties.
- Protect me from seducing spirits and give me wisdom in relationships (1 John 4:1, Matthew 7:15–20).

10. Enter God's Peace & Destroy Confusion

Why: Confusion and chaos are enemy tactics to paralyze faith. Peace centers the mind and emotions, allowing clear spiritual focus and confidence (Isaiah 26:3).

- I declare peace over my mind and emotions.
- I reject the spirit of confusion and chaos—it is not from you.
- Let your Word be my anchor and truth my foundation.
- Even in spiritual warfare, I rest in the Prince of Peace (Isaiah 26:3, 1 Corinthians 14:33).

11. Hold Onto God's Word & Prophetic Promises

Why: God's Word is a sword in spiritual warfare. Speaking and standing on Scripture releases power and defeats the enemy's lies (Isaiah 55:11).

- Father, I declare your Word over my life.
- I stand on every promise spoken in Scripture and confirmed in prayer.
- Where the enemy speaks doubt, I speak truth.
- Your Word does not return void—it accomplishes all you've sent it to do (Isaiah 55:11, Joshua 1:8).

12. Surrender Control & Embrace God's Will

Why: Control and manipulation come from fear and pride. Surrender brings freedom, aligns believers with God's perfect plan, and removes spiritual resistance (Matthew 6:10).

- I release the illusion of control and submit my plans to you.
- Your ways are higher and better than mine.
- Teach me to let go of striving, manipulation, and fear-based decisions.
- Your will, not mine, be done (Matthew 6:10, Isaiah 55:8–9).

13. Shine in Darkness & Be a Bold Witness

Why: The enemy thrives in hiddenness and fear. Bold living and speaking the truth expose darkness and extend God's kingdom (Matthew 5:14-16).

- Make me a burning light in the darkness.
- Let your presence in me expose and expel every hidden work of the enemy.
- Give me boldness to speak truth in love and live holy, even when it costs me popularity or comfort (Matthew 5:14–16, John 1:5).

14. Break Night Terrors & Claim Rest

Why: The enemy attacks in vulnerable times like sleep. Claiming peace and protection breaks spiritual oppression and restores strength (Psalm 4:8).

- In Jesus' name, I rebuke every spirit of torment, fear, and unrest.
- My dreams belong to the Lord.
- Surround my home with your angels.
- Let me sleep in peace and rise refreshed, full of your strength (Psalm 4:8, Proverbs 3:24).

15. Full Victory Declaration Prayer

Why: Declaring victory affirms faith, activates authority, and shuts down enemy schemes. It's the final step that seals spiritual breakthroughs (Luke 10:19).

- Lord, thank you for the cross, the blood, and the power of the resurrection.
- You've given me authority to tear down strongholds, cancel assignments of darkness, and walk in divine purpose.
- I declare that every chain is broken, every lie is silenced, and every plot of the enemy is overturned.
- Fill me with boldness, discernment, and relentless faith.
- In Jesus' name, amen.

100 Spiritual Warfare Prayer Points:

The weapons of spiritual warfare include praise, prayer, fasting, faith, reading and reciting the Word of God, and imitating Jesus Christ's kindness and love. Additionally, prayers using the scriptures are the most powerful. They remind believers that God's word is true for our lives.

1. Spiritual Armor Prayers

My friend, remember to go into spiritual war with armor on. Without it, you are weak to fiery darts that the enemy sends.

- O Lord, strengthen me to put on the full armor of God so that when the day of evil comes, I may be able to stand my ground no matter what. Because of you, I will remain in peace when I put on spiritual armor. In faith, I put on the belt of truth and shoes of readiness so I can stand firm in every trial. I put on the helmet of salvation to believe that I am truly saved despite my past.
- Thank you, God, that you've purified me by the blood. And in the name of Jesus,
 I will pick up my word to defeat every lie and attack of Satan. With your strength,
 I will "take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word
 of God." (Ephesians 6:12-20)
- Father God, I humbly ask for discernment to comprehend Your thoughts and the
 perseverance to "pray at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication..."
 (Ephesians 6:12-20). Guide me in staying vigilant and steadfast in my prayers,
 that I may remain aligned with Your will and purpose. Amen.

- Father, help me to be mentally and spiritually strong to win spiritual battles. I thank you that I'm sober-minded and I hear my Father's voice clearly.
- Thank you, God, for what you're about to do today. I rejoice as I hear the sound
 of chains breaking, strongholds loosening, and the enemies' plans being exposed
 and destroyed. Today, I choose to believe your word and "take up the shield of
 faith", so I can "extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one." I thank you God
 that Satan will not win today. (Ephesians 6:16-17)

- O Lord, I will stand in Your truth and refuse to listen to the father of lies. I believe You, God, when You said that You grant peace to us in spiritual battles, and I trust that You have saved me with Your blood. With Your strength, I will "Stand firm... with the belt of truth buckled around my waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with my feet fitted with the readiness that comes from Your gospel of peace." (Ephesians 6:14-15)
- Lord, thank you for granting me dominion and strategy to trample over every demonic assignment today. Today, I choose to believe that you have removed every curse, stronghold, and attack meant for me. "I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you." (Luke 10:19)
- I declare that every demonic spirit that approaches me must return to the pit of hell. In the name of Jesus, I rebuke every strategy of the enemy on my family and within my life. I rejoice because you <u>protect me</u>, O Lord. I thank you that I can find safety under your wing.
- Thank you, Father, that you're not a dead idol but the living God who still operates in signs, miracles, and wonders. Today, I stand in agreement for your will, O Lord. I ask for the strength to conquer daily spiritual attacks.

2. Prayers for a Heavenly Mindset

When you go into spiritual warfare, it's important that you focus on God and NOT the Devil's schemes. The enemy wants you to get distracted and focus on the negative, so you don't see the good happening.

Heavenly Father, Grant me a sober mind as I engage in spiritual warfare. Help
me to focus on your faithfulness in my life and the powerful stories of victory in
your Word. As I meditate on what is true, noble, right, pure, lovely, and
admirable, may my thoughts be centered on you. (Philippians 4:8)

 Lord Jesus, I set my mind on things above, where you are seated at the right hand of God. Strengthen me to keep seeking the things of Christ and to avoid being distracted by earthly concerns. I trust in your fairness and sovereignty over every aspect of my life. (Colossians 3:1-2)

I am confident that you will turn every situation into a blessing

- Holy Spirit, Guard my mind from the lies, deceptions, and <u>fiery darts</u> of the enemy. Help me to stay alert and of sober mind, knowing that the devil seeks to devour and destroy. May I resist his schemes with the truth of your Word. (1 Peter 5:8)
- God of peace, Thank you for the peace that surpasses all understanding, which guards my heart and mind in Christ Jesus. Despite the warfare around me, I am anchored in your peace and trust in your unfailing protection. (Philippians 4:7)
- Gracious Father, I praise you for your promise to work all things together for good for those who love you. Even in the midst of trials and challenges, I am confident that you will turn every situation into a blessing. Your faithfulness endures forever.

3. Prayer Against Principalities and Powers

Remember to attack Satan in prayer, don't attack people. Satan's goal is to get you to focus on what people did wrong, so you can be suspicious, fearful, angry, and offended. So, remember,"we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places." Ephesians 6:12

- Heavenly Father, I declare breakthrough in every place I step foot into. Lord, I
 ask you to break every chain and uproot every problem in my workplace, church,
 home, and life. I rejoice in the freedom that comes from your Spirit, for where
 your presence is, there is liberty. (2 Corinthians 3:17)
- In the mighty name of Jesus, I rebuke every evil work of the enemy that seeks to bring darkness into my life and surroundings. Lord, I ask for your divine love to shine brightly and expose the hidden works of darkness. Your blood has the power to remove all traces of envy, selfish ambition, and strife, for where these exist, confusion and every form of evil thrive. (James 3:16)
- By the authority given to me in Christ, I command every spirit of darkness to flee from my presence and from the places where I dwell. Let your light, Lord, penetrate every corner of my life, dispelling all darkness and bringing forth your peace and righteousness. May your love reign supreme, In Jesus' name, Amen.

Keep my focus fixed on you, Lord, and shield me from the enemy's schemes

- Lord Jesus, Strengthen me against spiritual attacks and help me to stand firm in your truth. Keep my focus fixed on you, Lord, and shield me from the enemy's schemes. With your help, I will remain righteous and draw closer to you each day.
- Gracious God, Teach me to pray for those who have hurt me, knowing that the
 enemy is using them against me. I declare your justice over my heart and ask for
 healing for those who have wronged me. Help me to remember that our battle is
 not against flesh and blood, but against the spiritual forces of darkness.
 (Ephesians 6:12)
- Thank you, Lord, for equipping me with the weapons of honesty, love, truth, patience, and kindness. May I be a shining example of your love even in the face of adversity. I humbly submit my needs to you O' Lord, for I rely on your divine power to demolish strongholds and bring every thought into obedience to Christ. (2 Corinthians 10:3-5)

4. Prayer for God's Justice

Satan wants you to give people what they deserve. However, you should NEVER seek revenge. Instead, defeat His plans with Love! Remember, "The LORD will fight for you; you need only to be still." (Exodus 14:14)

- Heavenly Father, I come before you with a heart of gratitude, knowing that you fight my battles on my behalf. I am reassured by your promise in Exodus 14:14 that I need only to be still, for you are dependable, trustworthy, and victorious. (Exodus 14:14)
- Jehovah-shalom, you are the God of peace. Thank you for helping me remain calm and focused despite the accusations of my enemies. I am grateful that this trial is temporary and that you will fight for me. (Proverbs 19:5)
- Lord, empower me to obey your commandments, Help me to love my enemies and pray for those who persecute me, as instructed in Matthew 5:43-48.
 Strengthen my heart with love and fortify my spirit to fulfill your will, even when it becomes challenging.
- Father God, I seek your assistance in following Psalm 37:1-4, where I am
 instructed not to fret because of evildoers but to trust in you and do good. Grant
 me the ability relax and to delight in you, knowing that you will fulfill the desires of
 my heart.
- Abba father, thank you for enabling me to love others unconditionally, even when they hurt me and do wrong. Help me to be like Christ, that demonstrated great love for us. For He, sacrificed His life for us even while we were still sinners. (Romans 5:8)
- May every soul come to know you intimately, I pray that everyone learns to love as you do and grows in intimacy with you. Only through you can our souls find fulfillment and satisfaction. Fill us, O Lord, and quench our thirsty and desperate souls, for you are love itself. (1 Peter 4:8)

Thank you for helping me remain calm and focused despite the accusations of my enemies.

- Jehovah-shalom, you are the God of peace. Thank you for helping me remain calm and focused despite the accusations of my enemies. I am grateful that this trial is temporary and that you will fight for me. (Proverbs 19:5)
- O' Lord, help me to do as your word says and love my "enemies and pray for those who persecute" me. Give me a heart of love and a strong spirit to fulfill your command, for it gets hard. (Matthew 5:43-48)
- Father God, I ask for your help that I would not "Fret because of evildoers" nor be "be not envious of wrongdoers", For your word promises that "they will soon fade like the grass and wither like the green herb." With your help father, I will Trust in the Lord, and do good. For your word assures me that if I "Delight yourself in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart." Psalm 37:1-4
- I come before you with a heart filled with gratitude for your love and guidance. Your word instructs us in Matthew 5:43-48 to love our "enemies and pray for

- those who persecute" us. Lord, I ask for your help in obeying this command, for it can be challenging without your strength and grace.
- I pray, Lord, that everyone may come to know and experience your love, which fills our souls and satisfies our deepest longings. Quench our thirsty souls, O Lord, and draw us closer to you each day (1 Peter 4:8).

Fill us O' lord. Quench our thirsty and desperate souls.

- Thank you, Lord, for enabling me to love others, even when they wrong me. Your
 love is the ultimate example of forgiveness and mercy, as Romans 5:8 reminds
 us: "But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died
 for us." Help me to extend that same love and mercy to those around me.
- Grant me, Father, the ability to forgive others just as Jesus forgave those who hurt him. Help me to be kind and tenderhearted, forgiving others as you have forgiven me (Ephesians 4:32).
- Guide me, O God, in learning how to love well and establish healthy boundaries in my relationships. Show me, Lord, who should be in my inner circle, and help me to love earnestly, covering a multitude of sins (1 John 4:8).
- Lord, help me to love you wholeheartedly and to love my neighbor as myself, as Jesus commanded. May my love for you overflow into love for others, seeing the "treasure in each person" created in your image (Mark 12:29-31).
- Finally, I pray for the strength to pursue holiness and peace with all, including my enemies. Grant me the wisdom to strive for peace while standing firm in your truth (Hebrews 12:14).

5. Prayer to Believe God is Good

The enemy is the father of lies and He wants to convince you that God is a liar and His word isn't true. He also wants you to think that God is just judging you and that He wants to punish you. These prayers are designed to remind you that God does everything from truth and love. Please don't believe lies about God's character.

Abba, as I seek to trust in your plan, I'm reminded of your promise in 2 Peter 3:9.
Thank you that you, O' Lord, are "not slow in keeping his promise, as some
understand slowness." Instead, you are "patient... not wishing that any should
perish, but that all should reach repentance." Help me trust in your timing as you
work all things together for good.

- Lord, as I surrender my fears to you, I cling to the truth in John 8:32, "...[that] the truth will set [me] free." Grant me the strength to walk in obedience, finding joy in following your ways.
- In the midst of life's trials, I find comfort in Romans 5:3-5, "...suffering produces endurance, character, and hope." Strengthen me, Lord, as I endure, knowing that my hope is found in you.
- Thank you for your unwavering faithfulness, O Lord. As your Word declares in Numbers 23:19, "God is not man, that he should lie..." May I rest in the assurance of your promises, trusting that you are faithful to fulfill them.
- As I navigate doubts and fears, cleanse my soul and increase my faith, knowing that your discipline is a sign of your love, as stated in Proverbs 3:11-12, "...the Lord disciplines those he loves..." Help me embrace your correction and grow closer to you.

6. Prayer to Seek God in Prayer + Fasting

Intimacy with God matters. And, prayer and fasting changes things. However, for <u>prayer</u> and <u>fasting</u> to be powerful it must be done from a pure heart and with complete dependence on God.

- Lord, I surrender every aspect of my being to You, asking for Your cleansing touch to remove anything not in harmony with Your Word. Just as You call us to return to You with fasting, weeping, and mourning (Joel 2:12), I humbly seek Your purification in my life.
- Hallelujah O' Lord! I am grateful for the assurance that my prayers, fasting, and service to You are not in vain. As I seek Your presence, I am comforted by Your promise in Jeremiah 29:13 that "You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart." Thank You for revealing Yourself to me in every aspect of my life.
- Lord, I find comfort in Your protection and the peace You provide. In Philippians
 4:6, You remind me not to be anxious but to bring every concern to You in prayer.
 Help me to trust in Your power and find peace in Your presence amidst any
 situation that may cause fear.
- Guide me, O Lord, to walk in Your ways and refrain from strife. Your Word in 1
 Timothy 2:8 encourages me to maintain a spirit of prayer and praise, lifting holy
 hands without contention. Grant me the grace to cultivate a heart of gratitude and
 worship in all circumstances.

- God, empower me to break free from any strongholds hindering my spiritual growth and keeping me bound in unhealthy patterns. I draw strength from Matthew 17:21, knowing that through prayer and fasting, I can overcome the challenges that seek to hold me captive.
- Thank You, Father, for Your divine plan and the assurance that Your purposes will prevail. Your heart for the hungry, the poor, and the oppressed is reflected in Isaiah 58:6-7, inspiring me to join You in bringing freedom and relief to those in need.
- Grant me, O Lord, the perseverance to continue praying fervently for Your will to be accomplished on earth. As I abide in constant prayer, rejoicing, and giving thanks, I embrace Your will, as outlined in 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, for my life and for the world around me.

7. Prayer for a Pure Heart

Ask God to create a clean and PURE heart in you, so you can see His plans for the world. "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God." Psalms 119:9

- Gracious God, as we seek to renew our hearts and minds, may we clearly
 discern your plans for us. Guide us to live according to your Holy standards, as
 Matthew 5:8 reminds us, "How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding
 it according to your word."
- Heavenly Father, we thank you for purifying us and drawing us closer to you.
 Grant us clean hands and pure hearts so I can stand your Holy place O' Lord. As Psalm 24:3-4 declares, "Who shall ascend the hill of the Lord? And who shall stand in his holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart..."
- Thank you, God, for transforming our thoughts and freeing us from unhealthy patterns. Help us to be renewed by your Word, as Romans 12:2 teaches, "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind..."
- Lord, search our hearts for any hidden sin and lead us into Heavenly wisdom and peace. James 3:16-18 reminds us, "For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every vile practice. But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable..."
- We thank you, Lord, for your promise to reveal the unknown aspects of our lives. Jeremiah 33:3 assures us, "Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known."
- Help us, O God, to align our choices with your will. May your kingdom come and your will be done, as Matthew 6:9-13 guides us, "Pray then like this: 'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the meaning of spiritual warfare?

Spiritual warfare is a fight between Satan's army and God's army in the spiritual realm. When the battle is intense it spills onto the earth through mean comments, envy, rage, murder, addictions, back sliding, pride, etc. We must actively fight against being the person that is doing the devil's work. We must be on guard for every little thing we do. Also, we should pray for the people that are blind because they do Satan's work unknowingly.

How do you start a warfare prayer?

Starting with thanksgiving is a strategy to appreciate God and set the mood of gratitude. Listing the things that God has done for you increases your faith that He will continue to fight the battle for you. However, there isn't a specific way to pray other than the Lord's Prayer. I break down that prayer in how to pray for beginners and explain each scriptures based on Jesus' prayer example.

Is prayer a spiritual weapon?

Yes, prayer is a dangerous spiritual weapon. During prayer God directs you to his plan and gives you strength to keep going. I think of it as a meeting with God where he tells you His plans to defeat the enemy.

Using the Bible verses about fighting battles with God's peace in your prayers, is a powerful strategy to defeat the enemy in your life and the lives of your loved ones.

Is praise a spiritual weapon?

Praise is a spiritual weapon because it teaches you to be thankful and faithful despite the war around you.

What are spiritual strongholds?

Spiritual strongholds are bad patterns that the enemy keeps people stuck in. For instance, addiction is a stronghold. Usually this stronghold is generational and requires prayer, fasting, therapy, and other avenues to break the chain of bondage.
